From the State House to the White House to the Congress to health care providers themselves — changes to the health care system that we know are being proposed and could be decided in the next couple of years. Personal health care consumes 18% of NH's economy or 18 cents of every dollar, totaling \$10.16 billion in 2007. Twenty years ago, spending on personal health care was less than 10% of NH's economy. Twenty years from now, health care is projected to reach nearly 20% to 25% of NH economic activity (NH Center for Public Policy Studies)
